ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 168 THAT ESTABLISHED A POLICY TO PROVIDE A NO BRUSHING PLAN FOR PROPERTY OWNERS ABUTTING THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2004, the City Council of Dunes City adopted Ordinance No. 168, which established a policy to provide a No Brushing Plan including a "No Brushing" Agreement; and

WHEREAS, at their regularly scheduled meeting on December 16th, 2013, the Dunes City Road Commission voted unanimously to recommend that the City Council repeal Ordinance No. 168; and

WHEREAS, when the Road Commission determines that vegetation on a City right-of-way is in need of brushing control, the City can brush without notice or consent from the property owner that abuts the City right-of-way.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) calendar days after adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DUNES CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:
