ORDINANCE NO. 257

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF HELKAT TRAIL, ESTABLISHED AS A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY BY THE BUCKSKIN BOB CAMP SUBDIVISION DATED 30 JUNE 1910

WHEREAS, the Dunes City street currently known as Helkat Trail was platted and established as a fifty-foot (50') wide, twenty-two hundred foot (2,200') long public right-of-way by the Buckskin Bob Camp Subdivision dated 30 June 1910. A copy of the Buckskin Bob Camp Subdivision Map is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Helkat Trail is within the city limits of the City of Dunes City and not owned by Lane County; and

WHEREAS, Helkat Trail was established to provide public access; and

WHEREAS, Dunes City Code 155.4.3.200(F) provides: <u>Vacation of streets</u>. All street vacations shall comply with the procedures and standards set forth in ORS Section 271; and

WHEREAS, ORS 271.080 (Vacation in incorporated cities) provides: (1) Whenever any person interested in any real property in an incorporated city in this state desires to vacate all or part of any street, avenue, boulevard, alley, plat, public square or other public place, such person may file a petition therefore setting forth a description of the ground proposed to be vacated, the purpose for which the ground is proposed to be used and the reason for such vacation; and

WHEREAS, such petition was made by Gregory K. Bonham and Jacqueline T. Bonham, husband and wife, 2 July 2020. A copy of the petition is attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, ORS 271.080 (Vacation in incorporated cities) provides: (2) There shall be appended to such petition, as a part thereof and as a basis for granting the same, the consent of the owners of all abutting property and of not less than two-thirds in area of the real property affected thereby; and

WHEREAS, written consents from the owners of all abutting property and not less than twothirds in area of the real property affected were submitted to the Dunes City Recorder by petitioners and are on file at Dunes City City Hall; and

WHEREAS, ORS 271.120 (Hearing; Determination) requires the City's governing body to hear the petition and any objections filed thereto in a public hearing and determine whether the consent of the owners of the requisite area has been obtained, whether notice has been duly given and whether the public interest will be prejudiced by the vacation of such plat or street or parts thereof; and

WHEREAS, Dunes City's City Council held a public hearing on 23 September 2020 pursuant to ORS 271.120 which was duly noticed and posted pursuant to ORS 271.110 (Notice of Hearing), and the City Council determined that the consent of the owners in the requisite area had been obtained, that there were no objections to the vacation from the public, and that posted notices had been provided pursuant to ORS 271.110(2); and

WHEREAS, after holding the public hearing on 23 September 2020, Dunes City's City Council determined that the public interest would not be prejudiced by the vacation of a portion of Helkat Trail as described in Exhibit B.

NOW, THEREFORE, DUNES CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The southern three-hundred foot (300') long portion of Helkat Trail established as a fifty-foot (50') wide public right-of-way by the Buckskin Bob Camp Plat dated 30 June 1910, at Book 4 Page 54, Lane County Real Property Records, and described in Exhibit B as that portion of Helkat Trail bordered on the east by Tax Lots 19-12-26-13, Map Numbers 1700, 1900, 2000, 2200, 2300, and 2400 and that portion of Helkat Trail bordered on the west by Tax Lots 19-12-26-13, Map Numbers 3000, 2900, 2800, 2700, and 2600 is hereby vacated. Title to the vacated land shall vest in the owners of the land bordering the vacated right-of-way in accordance with ORS 271.140. This vacation shall become effective only upon the recording by Lane County.

That portion of Helkat Trail bordered on the east by Tax Lots 19-12-26-13, Map Numbers 1700, 1900, 2000, 2200, 2300, and 2400; and

That portion of Helkat Trail bordered on the west by Tax Lots 19-12-26-13, Map Numbers 3000, 2900, 2800, 2700, and 2600; and
