#### 6. Announcements / Correspondence

- A. The Dunes City Budget Committee is meeting every Tuesday evening At 5:00 p.m. The public is welcome to attend the meetings in person, or may attend virtually by using the Go-To-Meeting platform. Information will be posted on the City's website prior to each meeting.
- B. Individuals who receive their water from Woahink Lake by relying on the City's water right permit (the Dunes City Shared Domestic Water Supply Program) must have their meters replaced with radio read meters and approved fish screens installed with information regarding pumps, gallons per minute, horsepower and pipe size to Dunes City before October 1, 2022. Contact City Hall for more information.

Dunes City Hall is accessible to the disabled. If special accommodations are needed, please contact the City Recorder at 541-997-3338 at least 48 hours in advance of the meeting so that appropriate assistance may be arranged.

- C. Dunes City has approved fish screens available for purchase by reimbursing the City for costs incurred in paying to have the fish screen constructed. To purchase, contact City Hall. Orders will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Installation must be done by a plumber. Your plumber can also provide you with the information the City must report to the State (pump size, GPM, hp, etc) and must be reminded to take a photo of the fish screen installed on the pump before returning the pump into the water and to email the photo to the property owner and the City.
- D. A reminder to the residents of Dunes City: Accessory dwellings are not allowed in Dunes City due to septic considerations and water quality concerns. Some have been approved through the Conditional Use process, but very few. This includes RVs. The City does not allow people to live in RVs on the property of another without the approval of the Planning Commission.
- E. A reminder to residents of Dunes City that Clear Lake Road, Pacific Avenue, Lake Boulevard, Darlings Loop and Canary Road are all Lane County Roads for which Dunes City has no control.
- F. Dunes City is seeking volunteers to help maintain its roadways as our former volunteer is not longer available. If you are interested in helping out, please contact Dunes City for further information.
